

DEMOCRATS AND REPUBLICANS

INCREASE IN ENROLLMENT

1929
 Tabulation for 1929 Shows Total of 4,613. Democrats in Putnam Now Total 1,422 and Republicans 3,191.

An increase of 371 enrolled voters in Putnam county for 1929 is shown by the tabulation made public this week by the Board of Elections, which shows a total of 4,613 enrolled democrats and republicans. There are 1,422 democrats enrolled, an increase of 140 over last year, while the republicans with an increase of 231 nwo total 3,191. It is interesting to note in the tabulation that of the 7,176 voters who cast ballots at the last election only 4,613 declared their party affiliations in order to vote in the primary election in September.
