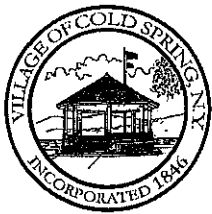


In response to your recent request, I hereby certify that the following offices should be voted on at the upcoming March 2016 election:
